
INSTALLATION


- 1. For indoor use only.

 - a.Place or hang the MillionAir™ Air pump above the aquarium, however the unit should not be placed where it could fall into the water.
 - b.If the MillionAir™ Air pump is placed below the aquarium a "check valve" is required.
- 4. Connect a piece of airline tubing to the air difuser.
- 5. Plug directly to a G.F.C.I. electrical outlet using a drip loop.
- 6. To ensure a optimum airflow, change or clean airstone on a regular basis.


